On October 9, 2007, at about 4:39 PM, The Hudson Police Department responded to Walmart Boulevard, the entrance to Sam's Club, for a reported disturbance and assault between two females. Upon arrival, Officers located the females involved. Upon initial investigation, it was determined an altercation, between occupants of a Toyota Scion, ensued in the left turn lane of Walmart Boulevard. The altercation escalated between two of the occupants and they eventually exited the vehicle. Arriving officers found one of the occupants, Jennifer Caterino, 21 years old of Nashua, NH, apparently injured and began to administer first aid. The other female directly involved was identified as Sara Eberhard, 20 years old, of Nashua, NH. The two are believed to be acquaintances. Caterino was attended to further by members of the Hudson Fire Department. She was transported to the Southern New Hampshire Medical Center for evaluation.

Eberhard was arrested at the scene for Second Degree Assault, a Class B Felony. She was additionally charged with Transportation of a Controlled Drug, a Misdemeanor. Her bail was set at \$500.00 Personal Recognizance. She was released on bail and is scheduled to for arraignment at the Nashua District Court on October 25, 2007.
